

Section 28 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Drive North to South

1. The shuttle starts from the Lowell Town Office (2170 Hwy 100, Lowell, VT) and at Craftsbury Outdoor Center (535 Lost Nation Road, Craftsbury Twn, VT).
2. From the Lowell Town Office go south 0.4 miles to VT 58. Turn left on VT 58 and go 8.7 miles then turn right on VT 14. Follow VT 14 south 12.3 miles to N Craftsbury Road.
3. Turn left on N Craftsbury Road and follow it about 1.5 miles to Wylie Hill Rd.
4. Turn left on Wylie Hill Road for about 0.1 mile then turn right on Mill Village Road.
5. Follow Mill Village Road for about 1.1 miles (there is a pronounced left bend at about 0.4 miles) and then turn right on Lost Nation Road for about 0.5 miles to Craftsbury Outdoor Center.
