

Section 19 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Drive North to South

1. From Fiedler Rd (S19 access point <4>) drive west on Camels Hump Rd for 2.0 miles (bear left at Salvas and at Taft roads).
2. Turn left on Main Rd and drive for 6.2 miles.
3. Turn left on Rt. 17 and drive 5.5 miles over Appalachian Gap for to the Battleground on your left (S19 access point <1>). Park along the south side of the access road. Do not block the dumpster.

Drive South to North

1. From the Battleground (S19 access point <1>) drive west over Appalachian Gap for 5.5 miles.
2. Turn right on Main Rd. toward Huntington and drive for 6.2 miles.
3. Turn right on Camels Hump Rd and drive 2.0 miles (bear right at Taft and at Salvas roads).
4. Turn left on Fiedler road (S19 access point <4>). Park at the end of the road but do not block building access.
