

Section 9 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Driving North to South

1. From Harry's on Hwy 103 drive south on 103 for about 0.1 miles.
2. Turn right on Healdville Rd and go 2.4 miles.
3. Bear right on Healdville Rd at the intersection with Hedgehog Hill Road and go 1.3 miles.
4. Bear left on W Church St and go 0.2 miles.
5. Turn left on Maple Hill Rd and go 0.4 miles.
6. Bear right on Maple Hill Rd at the intersection with Straight Rd and go 1.0 miles.
7. Turn left on Hwy 155 and go 5.2 miles to the intersection with Hwy 100. (The Catamount Trail crosses Hwy 155 about 2 miles from this turn just past Government Rd.)
8. Continue south on Hwy 100 for 1.5 miles
9. Turn right on Greendale road and drive about 2 miles to the end of plowing.
