## Invitation to Comment – Please Reply by July 15, 2022 Dutch Hill Glade Additions Project

Dear Interested Parties:

The USDA Forest Service is initiating an environmental analysis process for the proposed Dutch Hill Glade Additions Project under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The proposed action would add three new 200-foot wide glades for backcountry skiing by removing low quality trees under 5 inches diameter at breast height and maintaining a vista at the true Dutch Hill summit. The work would be completed in cooperation and partnership with the Dutch Hill Alliance of Skiers and Hikers (DHASH). Please refer to the attached project information documents for additional details regarding the proposed action.

This proposal potentially falls in a category of actions excluded from analysis in an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, as proposals of this type individually and cumulatively do not have a significant effect on the environment. This proposal appears to fall under the following categories:

36 CFR 220.6 (e)(22): Construction, reconstruction, decommissioning, or disposal of buildings, infrastructure, or improvements at an existing recreation site, including infrastructure or improvements that are adjacent or connected to an existing recreation site and provide access or utilities for that site.
