## **Section 5 Shuttle**

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

## **Drive North to South**

- 1. From 2165 Kendall Farm Rd in Bondville (S5 access point <3>) and drive east 2.1 miles.
- 2. Turn right on RT 30 and drive 1.2 miles.
- Turn right on Stratton Mountain Access Rd. and drive 4.8 miles (go through the ski area).
- 4. Turn right on Mountain Rd. and drive 4.4 miles.
- 5. Turn right on West Jamaica Rd and Drive 2.2 miles.
- 6. Turn right on Stratton-Arlington Rd in West Wardsboro (Stratton) and drive about 3.4 miles to #2165 to the end of plowing (S5 access point <1>).

## **Drive South to North**

- From 2083 Stratton-Arlington Road in West Wardsboro (Stratton) (S5 access point <1>) travel east 3.4 miles.
- 2. Turn left on West Jamaica Road and Drive 2.2 miles.
- 3. Turn left on Mountain Road and drive 4.4 miles.
- 4. Turn left on Stratton Mountain Access Road and Drive 4.8 miles.
- 5. Turn left on RT 30 and drive 1.2 miles.
- 6. Turn left on Kendall Farm Rd in Bondville and drive 2.1 miles to the end of plowing (S5 access point <3>).
