

Section 10 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Driving South to North

1. Start out going southeast from 696 Buttermilk Falls Rd, Ludlow, VT, on Buttermilk Falls Rd toward Rod and Gun Club Rd. Go 1.5 miles.
2. Stay on Buttermilk Falls Rd past Rod and Gun Club Rd.
3. Turn right onto VT-103 and go about 3.8 miles to Shunpike Rd just past Harry's.
4. Turn right on Shunpike Rd and travel about 1.4 miles to the first intersection and turn right on Lake Ninevah Rd.
5. Go about 2.2 miles on Lake Ninevah Rd to a 4 way intersection and turn right on Patch Brook Rd. for 0.5 miles to Townsend Farm Rd/Sawyer Hill Rd. Park at this intersection out of the way of traffic.

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
