## Section 13 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

## **Driving North to South**

- 1. Go south from Mountain Top (13 Mountain Spring Rd) on Mountain Spring Rd for 0.1 mi.
- 2. Turn right on Mountain Top road and go 1.8 mi (total 1.9 mi).
- 3. Turn right at a "T" after crossing a small bridge.
- 4. Continue south on Chittenden Road for 2.7 mi (total 4.7 mi).
- 5. Turn left on Meadow Lake Dr for 1.7 mi (total 6.4 mi).
- 6. Turn left on US 4 for 4.6 mi (total 11.0 mi). You will see the Long Trail parking (N43 39 58.1 W72 50 53.8) lot on the right.

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
