Section 14 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Driving South to North

- 1. Go south from Mountain Top (13 Mountain Spring Rd) for 0.1 miles.
- 2. Turn right on Mountain Top Rd and go 1.9 miles (total 2.0 mi).
- 3. Turn right on Chittenden Rd (pass Holden Rd) and go 1.2 miles (total 3.1 mi).
- 4. Turn right on Sangamon Rd and drive 2.2 mi (total 5.4 mi).
- 5. Turn right on VT 7 and go 7.8 mi (total 13.2 mi).
- 6. Turn right on McConnell Rd and go 3.3 mi (total 16.5 mi).
- 7. Turn right on RT 73 and go 5.4 miles to the LT parking lot (N43 50 23.9 W72 58 07.1) on the right (total 21.9 mi).

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
