

Section 21 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Drive North to South

1. From Bolton Valley Nordic (S21 access <3>) drive south on the Bolton Valley Access Rd for 4.3 miles.
2. Turn left on RT 2 and drive 1.8 miles.
3. Turn left on Pineo Brook Rd (S21 access <1>). Park in the plowed area. Do not block access.

Drive South to North

1. From Pineo Brook Rd (S21 access <1>) turn right and drive west on Rt 2 for 1.8 miles.
2. Turn right on Bolton Valley Access Rd and drive 4.3 miles to Bolton Valley Nordic. (S21 access <3>).
