

Section 27 Shuttle

These are driving directions for shuttling cars during the weeklong tour. Please use caution and common sense when using these directions. Some roads may not have signs. After a heavy snow it may be difficult to locate the trailhead or end-of-plowing. Your GPS will not replicate all of these routes and may direct you to a road that is closed and impassable. When in doubt, follow someone familiar with the local area. Look for blazes or CT parking signs which may be present. If the road seems impassible, park and explore on foot. Always park clear of access roads and gates. Leave room for others to park including snowmobile trailers.

The location of the Catamount Trail on these maps is approximate. Temporary reroutes are not displayed. Always visit the Catamount Trail Association website for the latest trail information and maps.

The shuttle routes are indicated in magenta or green. The Catamount Trail is indicated in blue.

Drive North to South

1. The shuttle starts from Craftsbury Outdoor Center (535 Lost Nation Road, Craftsbury Twn, VT) and ends at 1295 Eden Mountain Road in Craftsbury Twn, VT.
2. From the Craftsbury Outdoor Center go west (left) 0.5 miles to Mill Village Road.
3. Turn left on Mill Village Road and follow it for about 1.1 miles (there is a pronounced right bend at 0.7 miles) to Wylie Hill Road.
4. Turn Left on Wylie Hill Road for a few feet and then right on Post Road Extension. Follow Post Road Extension for 1.4 miles to VT 14.
5. Turn left on VT14 and go 0.4 miles then turn right on Branch Road. After 0.4 miles bear right on Collinsville road. After 1.5 miles bear left on Eden Mountain Road.
6. In 1.2 miles you will see a small parking area on the left with a large pile of dirt at the back. There are no trail markers at this trail head.
